# GLOBAL VISION OF GANDHIJI: ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION IDEAS

The thoughts and ideas given by Gandhiji the modern initiatives for environment preservation can be observed. He firmly believed that as human will go on empowering the nature he will become more and more alienated from it. This is the base of modern green movement. Gandhiji have given the gift of his thoughts to the world, of which in the context of present problems if we see the consistency of his ideas,

He firmly believed that, verse of Ishavasya Upanishad should be discovered by sacrificing and donating. He has always ignored the materialism. In Manchester like Ahmedabad, he established the Ashram on the bank of river abarmati. Gave the principle of saint culture in city culture. He says 'My life is my message' and presented his ideals of life to the world. In context of this, our Honourable Chief Minister Shri Narendra Modi said in this speech that he was the man to hold the lowest carbon foot print in his lifetime.

#### GANDHIJI'S IDEAS FOR CLEANLINESS AND PUBLIC HEALTH.

For cleanliness and public health Gandhiji believed that in 'divinity is in cleanliness'. He did cleaning on hihis own. He preformed cleanliness movement at that time through which a healthy society can be created. He believed that the clean natural environment automatically strengthens the mind and body. In letter dated- 11-1-1913 he wrote that nature has given the medium for it in the body. So when body is sick we have to understand that there is some impurity in our body and body has started the process of purifying it. According to the excerpt of his letter dated- 4-8-1946, My idea of developing nature care in Urulikanchan and the villages of India is fast expanding. It means teaching is hygiene of the body, mind and soul of the individual and society. Thus the workers in Urulikanchan have, besides cleaning the streets of the village and attending to their bodily ailments through the judicious use of earth, sun either, light and water to the attend the pauperism of the criminal tubes called the garndis described in law as one of the criminal tribes of India. The thoughts given above are about the natural treatment which is entirely dependent on natural environment. If this natural environment is corrupted then the health of entire human race will be endangered.

In Gandhiji's words, the earth, the air, the land and water are not an inheritance from our fore fathers but on loan from our children. So we have to handover to them at least as it been handed over to us.

He gives much importance to diet purification. There is an unbreakable relation between diet- mind and nature. Today, this view point has also been scientifically proven. By checking the diet of Gandhiji through religious, scientific pragmatic vision said that, as man live together but don't each other, similarly man has gotten the kingdom of nature( animals, birds and other living things) but he shouldn't be eating it.

#### GANDHIJI'S IDEAS ABOUT THE BALANCE OF ENVIRON-MENT AND SOCIETY

For welfare of society Gandhiji gave the ideal for simple living and high thinking. Took initiative to return to nature and re-awakened the saint culture. Gandhiji's ideas or methods are not same and his far-sightedness is not framed or final. He established 'Tolstoy Karm' and 'Pheonix Ashram' in South Africa. In Ahmedabad he established first Kochrab Ashram (1915), Sabarmati Ashram and Harijan Ashram. This is the perfect vision point of the love of nature.

From the Tolstoy's book 'Vaikunth is in your Heart' created the ideal for world of love and welfare of society. According to Gandhiji Varnashram is the unique gift given to world by Hindu culture. In his opinion sacrifice is the function of Varnashram. Brahmin of his knowledge,

Kshatriya of his protection power, Vaishya of his trading power and Shudra of his body used to do the sacrifice.

# GANDHIJI'S VISION ON POLLUTION FREE AGRICULTURE AND ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

Gandhiji said that true India is located in 7 lakh villages. And to make the village economy self-sufficient and to maintain cleanliness, health and elegance and to make this he presented the ideal for agriculture that were practical but also protecting the nature geographically.

Both makes self-sufficient with fulfilling the basic needs with the environment conversation policy can be seen. For this he states that,

To improve the condition of rural area I want to make agriculture, animal husbandry and other village industries to make them healthy and self-sufficient on the basis of universe.

#### Gandhiji's long-term vision= disagree with modern agriculture.

For modern agriculture that is done by using large amount of electricity and steam, for that in starting only Gandhiji said that to obtain profit from the farming, the fertility of the land will decrease. To ripe the crops fertilizers of hard work shall be used instead of chemical fertilizers. This thought clearly states that the such means in agriculture shall be used that can maintain the balance of nature.

Further Gandhiji stated that for economy of village the base is pure and healthy food with proper amount of pure ghee, milk, and oil shall be obtained. And also gives the importance to pure water. Gandhiji said that by tractor land will be cultivated and water pumps will be used for machine making the villages the slave of cities. They will have to go to cities for buying the tractors and have to be dependent to install the water machines and pumps.as a result village not be independent from the capital economy. He said in Hind Swaraj that, due to railway man made causalities increased. As a result of pollution will increase. And so he said that what will man receive if he receives the whole world in exchange of their soul? Means by protecting environment development shall be connected. Development done by harming the environment is not development but destruction.

Traditionally farmers will have lack of knowledge, but will have almost all the ideals for living the life. For example- on Akhatrij farmer will start farming. These cultural and spiritual features will be seen in the blood of farmers. But these ideals will not be seen in the farmers of Europe. And thus, Gandhiji stated that, if farmers use the modern farming then many changes will be seen in their simple life creating imbalance in the environment. This situation can be clearly seen today. Gandhiji's ideas shall be reawakened to maintain the self-sufficiency to maintain village economy and environmental balance.
