- 4. There is no significant use of internet for amusement by class 9-12 school students.


#### Methodology:

Data shows that for study 4% students of class-9, 7% students of class-10, 12% students of class-11 and 13% students of class-12 use internet. Hence hypothesis 1, there is no significant use of internet for study is accepted.

No. of internet user students for social connectivity found 18% from class 9, 22% from class 10, 28% from class 11 and 31% from class 12. Thus hypothesis 2, there is no significant use of internet for social connectivity is rejected.

Games related data indicates that class 9 students user are 34%, class 10 user are 36%, class 11 user are 39% and class 12 user are 43%. Therefore, hypothesis 3, there is no significant use of internet for games is rejected.

For amusement class 9 user are 29%, class 10 user are 30%, class 11 and class 12 user are 32%. Hence hypothesis 4, there is no significant use of internet for amusement is rejected.

## Conclusion:

Students are very much addicted to social media and sites. These sites harm them a lot as they impact their way of living and academic activities. Though the internet has lots of merits, it does have lots of demerits which are harmful for their mental, physical and moral development.
