

Theme, Content, Structure and Use of Web 2.0 Tools in The Library Blogs of Selected Kendriya Vidyalayas of Tamilnadu: a State of the Art Study of School Library Blogs

ABSTRACT
Purpose: The study reports the URLs and domain of eight KV Library blogs, themes and column structure, the variety of widgets used, the link categories provided, the online viewer statistics, the list of web 2.0 tools used, the multi-language readability, special taglines and the 'library information' made available in these blogs

Methodology: Google and KV Librarians Group were browsed and each and every KV Library blog was visited to collect the required data.

Findings: These blogs were taken birth after 2008. Four blogs have hindi readability option. All the blogs are in Wordpress domain. Almost all the blogs have used blogrolls and link categories. Only KV Narimedu, Madurai Libray blog has tamil translation facility, has more than 12,20,000 views, provides online social bookmarking service and has created 5 subject specific blogs. Some blogs have used web 2.0 tools. Only two blogs have made available their library OPAC in their blogs. All the blogs have necessary information about the library.

Future implications: The study can be further extended to larger number of library blogs of Kendriya Vidyalayas situated across the country.

Social implications: It acts as a guide to the librarians to see where they are and what they lack. It acts as a yardstick to the KVS authorities to bring out a' School Blog Policy' to standardise the content and presentation of KV Library blogs.

Introduction: Blogs

A blog is "a Web application that contains periodic, reverse chronologically ordered posts on a common Web page" (wikipedia, 2008). To Peter Scott (2001), a blog is "a page containing brief, chronologically arranged item of information. A blog can take the form of a diary, journal, what's new page or links to other websites".

Library blogs & School Library Blogs

The interactive web pages of a library which is frequently updated showing the posts in the reverse chronological order are called as Library Blogs. A library blog maintained either by the school authorities or the school librarian designed specially to cater to the needs of the students and teaching community of a particular school environment may be defined as a School Library Blog.

Use of School Library Blogs

- To tell about your library its resources, rules and regulations, services, statistics, magazines / periodicals, Library committee of the year, etc. to the visitors
- New arrivals display service
- Alert Services Article alert, Magazine/periodical alert, author alert, publisher alert etc.
- Online Information service on Demand / request by the
- Information Analysis and Consolidation Service (Search, edit, compile and provide service)
- An effective library advocacy tool / marketing tool
- An archive of library circulars / notices / announcements
- Ask your librarian service; Blog as an on-line digital library
- Current Awareness Service
- To provide scores of lists of useful websites / links to other sites / blogs
- A place holder for showcasing library events and activities (conferences, seminars, meets, cultural eves)
- To display the creative ideas / scholarly articles of the staff / users

- To show the archives / calendar of posts (day-wise, month-wise, year-wise)
- On-line library newsletter
- Topical displays on selected occasions
- Site statistics to see which posts are viewed more; so future plans can be made accordingly
- WEB OPAC of your library can be placed there
- To get feedback from users; feedback mechanism helps to plan and serve better
- Top clicks / posts / Fresh Posts can be displayed
- Automatic e-mail alerts to the interested users whenever a new post is published in your blog
- Library programmes can be brought into light (National Book Week, World Book Day, Dr.S.R.Ranganathan Day, Readers Club etc.)
- Post new book reviews of net sources and of your own users
- List of recommended books (term-wise, course-wise)
- Archive of project works done by the library users
- Online archive of question papers, sample papers, syllabus etc.
- As a reference desk
- To provide announcements of new library acquisitions, notice and various services of the library
- Conduct on-line polls and user surveys and
- To create more sub-blogs for interested departments provide a core set of topic categories for each sub-blog with the ability to add custom topic categories.

Kendriya Vidyalayas

The scheme of Kendriya Vidyalayas (Central Schools) was approved in Nov.1962 by the Govt. of India on the recommendations of the Second Central Pay Commission. It recommended that the Govt. should develop a scheme to provide uninterrupted education to the wards of transferable wards of transferable central Govt. employees. Central Schools Organization was started as a unit of the Ministry of Education (now MHRD) of the Govt. of India. Initially 20 Regimental schools, then functioning at places having large

concentration of defence personnel, were taken over as Central Schools during the academic year 1963-64. The Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan was registered as a society on 15-12-1965. Over the years, the number of Kendriya Vidyalayas steadily increased to 1073 as on 31/3/2011.

Methodology

- Google Search was done to find out the Kendriya Vidyalayas having library blogs, as the first step.
- KV Librarians Group (http://grou.ps/kvlibrarians): Secondly, a search was done in the KV Blogs directory available in the KV Librarians Group to trace out the library blogs of KVs in Tamilnadu.
- 11 KV Library blogs were traced and out of which 8 library blogs were selected by random sampling method.
- The URLs of these 8 blogs were browsed to get the required information
- 5. Tabulation was done to present the findings
- 6. Inferences were drawn based on the tabulated data.

Objectives of the Study

The following are the objectives of this blog survey.

- To list the URLs and domain of the KV Library blogs, under study
- To find out the themes and column structure of these blogs
- 3. To find out the variety of widgets used in these blogs
- 4. To find out the link categories provided in these blogs
- To find out the online viewer statistics as on the first week of December (5/6.12.2013)
- 6. To find out the list of web 2.0 tools used in these blogs
- To find out the multi-language readability and special taglines of these blogs and
- 8. To list the 'library information' made available in these blogs

Data Analysis and Interpretation

1. Table 1: URL and Domain It is inferred from the table that all the 8 library blogs were created in the Wordpress domain. Only two blog address start with KV and other 6 blog addresses start with the term 'library'.

It is clear that 6 library blogs have created interesting taglines and two blogs have none of that sort. One blog has no hit

counter and thus visit statistics is not available. Out of the remaining 7 blogs, KV Madurai library blog has 12,20,780 hits followed by KV OCF Avadi library blog with 22,875 hits and KV Nagercoil has the least of 855 hits.

It is clear that KV Madurai library blog has used more word-

press widgets and web 2.0 tools followed by KV Gill Nagar. Only KV Madurai has delicious service in the blog. KV Madurai and KV Gill Nagar have twitter account in-built in the blog. While 4 blogs have employed RSS service in the blog, most of the blogs have used share option and email subscription option in their blogs.

It is transparent from table 6 that only two KV Library blogs i.e. KV Gill and KV Nagercoil have made available their OPAC through their library blog online. Out of 8 blogs, 4 blogs have made the option to the online viewers to read the blog in Hindi (translated view of the blog) and only one blog viz KV Narimedu, Madurai has the blog readable in Tamil too.

All the blogs under study are of recent origin. KV AFS Sulur blog has its posts from the year 2008 and KV Narimedu, Madurai has its posts from 2010. Four blogs have started their origin in the year 2011 and KV Gill nagar is the latest blog which originated in 2013. Only in two blogs i.e. KV Narimedu, Madurai and KV Nagercoil, RSS feeds of few known

websites / blogs are incorporated.

Almost all the KV Library blogs have created a good number of link categories and useful links to websites on various important educational issues are created. Only KV Narimedu, Madurai has created five subject specific exclusive blogs to serve the online information seekers of different breed.

Conclusion

It is a good sign that a large number of libraries in Kendriya Vidyalaya Umbrella have started their school library blogs and serve their school fraternity online. But a kind of standardisation is to be established in presenting their contents. Though items like theme and structure of the blog to be chosen by the librarian concerned, other areas like use of library 2.0 tools, flying library opac can be standardised and insisted upon. Enough hands-on training and workships need to be organized to educate the KV School librarians in creating and customizing their school library blogs.
