Agriculture field:

APMC include re-charging of lakes, check dams, cattle camps, distribution of Tarpaulin farmers on concessions, farmer shibir, construction of godowns, drip irrigation.

(2) Health field:

Health field includes hospital, blood bank, removing blindness, sabbhavna charitable trust, treatment of chikngunia, 'Beti Bachavo' mission, healthy child year, swine flu camp, Ayurvedic hospital, Rotary club, Health centre, distribution of mosquito nets on concession etc.

(3) Education:

Under education, Lok kalyan trust, Kanya kelavani Mandal, rooms of primary school, encouraging girls education, distribution of books and notebooks and under "Vanche Gujarat", chief Ministers Kanya kelvani Nidhi, carpet distribution etc. are the help activities that are undertaken.

(4) Security:

In the field of Security also APMC gives help. For, this under accident insurance plan the premium is paid by APMC. Fund has been given for defense reason to police station building.

(5) Enlightened activities:

Enlightened activities by APMC include activities directly related to different class of society which include financial help at marriages. In addition to this, financial aid is also given to social institutions for advertisement.

(6) Natural calamities:

APMC helps during natural calamities also. For this Drought relief fund, chief Minister's relief fund, Kutch earthquake relief fund, flood affected relief fund, Tsunami relief funds are given.

Service Activity:

Provision of laboratory in the market yard for spices and soil test. An A.C.dining hall has been provided for pure meal at concession rate. Meal is provided in the dining hall at Rs.20. In addition to this, Tirupati Foundation, Tree Plantation, Crematorium, 24 hrs. Fire fighter service and ambulance service is also provided by APMC.

Government partnership:

Under the activities of partnership by government, people's fund is given for social services. Gokulgram yojana, Jyoti gram yojana, Information Technology etc.

APMC Unjha total income for the year 2009-2013 Rs.1195 lakh, Rs.1187 lakh, Rs.1118 lakh, Rs.1386 lakh, Rs.1695 lakh. Total income for these years was Rs.6581 lakh.

Net profit for the year's 2009- 2013 Rs.602 lakh, Rs.496 lakh, Rs. 327 lakh, Rs.334 lakh, Rs. 264 lakh respectively. Total net profit for these years is Rs.2023 lakh.

APMC Unjha has spent in the year 2009, for agriculture Rs.147 lakh, for health Rs.3 lakh, for education Rs.24 lakh, for Security Rs.45 lakh and for enlightened activities Rs.28 lakh.

APMC spent on natural calamity, social service and government partnership respectively Rs.217 lakh, 11 lakh and 297 lakh in the previous years. No change in its.

APMC Unjha has given during the year 2013 in Agriculture Rs.115 lakh, Health sector Rs.11 lakh, Education sector Rs.33 lakh, Service Activities Rs.1 lakh. Under Enlightened activity Rs.93 lakh less has been given then the previous year. For Security no change has been made then the previous years.

During 2009-13 total income is Rs.6581 lakhs under which agriculture Rs.409 lakh, health Rs.61 lakh, education Rs.193 lakh, Security Rs.122 lakh, Service Activities Rs.4 lakh. Like this total Rs.771 lakh have been given. Average every year 154.29 lakh have been given for social development.

During year 2009-13 in all fields, total Rs.247 lakh in 2009, Rs.188 lakh in 2010, Rs.97 in 2011, Rs.172 in 2012, Rs.67 in 2013 have been given. Which is 12% of the total income. During this year 771 lakh have been given, Every year average 154.29 lakh have been given and an average 19.29 lakh have been given in all these fields.

During 2009-13 these five years, in agriculture 6%, health sector 1%, education 3%, Security 2% have been given which is 12% of the total income.

Agriculture average 1.24%, health sector average 0.19%, education average 0.59%, Security average 0.37%. And service activity average 0.01% funds have been given. In all these fields average 2.34% funds have been given.

Conclusion:

By APMC Unjha, every year average 154.29 lakh funds are given for all these activities

Which is 2.34%.

Every year average 19.29 lakh are given for all these activities which is 0.29% .

No changes are noticed in natural calamity, government partnership.
