

A Study on the Influnece of Environmental Education Implemented in Middle School Level with Regarding Knowledge and Skill

KEYWORDS

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ABSTRACT The study was conducted on 606 middle school students to study their influence of environmental education implemented in middle school level with regarding Knowledge and Skills. A self made questionnaire was used to collect the data which was treated with statistical techniques. Results revealed that significant variation in the influence of environmental education Knowledge and Skills with to their gender, location of students, type of school and class of middle school students.

OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY

The present study sought to accomplish the following objectives.

To find out the difference, if any, in the level of influence of Environmental Education in middle school level with respect to gender in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

To find out the difference, if any, in the level of influence of Environmental Education in middle school level with respect to the locality of the students in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

To find out the difference, if any, in the level of influence of Environmental Education in middle school level with respect to the type of school in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

To find out the difference, if any, in the level of influence of Environmental Education in middle school level with respect to their standard of study in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

HYPOTHESIS OF THE STUDY

The following are the hypotheses of the study.

There is no significant difference in the level of influence on Environmental education between Boys and Girls in middle school level in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

There is no significant difference in the level of influence on Environmental education between rural and urban middle school students in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

There is no significant difference in the level of influence on Environmental Education among the middle school students studying in Government, Aided and Private schools in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

There is no significant difference in the level of influence on Environmental Education among the 6th, 7th and 8^{th stand-ard} students in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

RESEARCH METHOD

The present study aims at identifying the knowledge and skills of environmental education in middle school students. The present study used normative survey method. Questionnaires are the major tools used to collect relevant data from the students of middle schools in Tiruchirappalli District.

POPULATION AND SAMPLE

The present study covers the middle school students in Tiruchirappalli District. The total sample selected for this study is 606 and these samples were selected from 26 middle schools by means of simple random sampling technique.

STATISTICAL TECHNIQUES

Questionnaire is used for this study. The data collected were tabulated and analyzed in a proper way statistical techniques and inferential analysis. The following statistical techniques were used in the study.

Mean and standard deviation.

't' test for determining the significance of difference between two-sub groups variables. 'F' test (ANOVA) to find out the significance of variance among the sub groups variables.

There will be no significant difference in the level of influence on Environmental Education between Boys and Girls in middle school level in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

The above table reveals that the obtained't' value 3.62 is greater than the table values 1.96 at 0.05 level and 2.58 at 0.01 levels. So it is found that the't' value is significant at 0.01 levels for knowledge of environmental education.

The above table reveals that the obtained't' value 3.56 is greater than the table values 1.96 at 0.05 level and 2.58 at 0.01 levels. So it is found that the't' value is significant at 0.01 levels for skills of environmental education.

It also infers that the girls are having high level of environmental education knowledge and skills than the boys.

There will be no significant difference in the level of influence on Environmental education between school locality of rural and urban middle school students in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

0.01 levels for skills of environmental education.

It infers that there is a significant difference between the Rural and Urban middle school students in terms of knowledge and skills. Hence, the stated null hypothesis "There will be no significant difference between Rural and Urban middle school students in terms of Knowledge and Skills of Environmental education" is rejected and the alternative hypothesis is accepted.

It also infers that the school locality of urban middle school students is having high level of knowledge and skills of Environmental Education than the rural students.

Hypothesis: 3

There will be no significant difference in the level of influence on Environmental Education among the middle school students studying in Government, Aided and Private schools in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

The above table reveals that the obtained 'f' value 6.19 is greater than the table values 1.96 at 0.05 level and 2.58 at 0.01 levels. So it is found that the 'f' value is significant at 0.01 levels for skills of environmental education.

The above the table shows that the significant variance among the students studying in Government, Aided and Private middle school students in terms of Knowledge and Skills of Environmental Education. It found that the 'f' value is significant at 0.001 levels for Knowledge and Skills of Environmental Education. Hence, the null hypothesis is "there will be no significant variance among the students studying in Government, Aided and Private middle school in terms Knowledge and Skills of Environmental Education is rejected and the alternative hypothesis is accepted.

Hypothesis: 4

There will be no significant difference in the level of influence on Environmental Education among the 6^{th} , 7th and $8^{th \, standard}$ students in terms of Knowledge and Skills.

It is found that the 'f' value is significant at 0.001 levels for knowledge and skills on environmental education. FINDINGS OF THE STUDY

There is a significant difference between the Boys and Girls of middle schools in terms of Knowledge and Skills of Environmental Education.

There is a significant difference between the Rural and Urban middle school students in terms of Knowledge and Skills of Environmental Education.

There is a significant variance among the middle school students studying in Government, Aided and Private schools in terms of Knowledge and Skills of Environmental Education.

There is a significant variance among the 6^{th} , 7th and 8^{th} standard school students in terms of Knowledge and Skills of Environmental Education.

CONCLUSION

Clean environment is one of the most important of our life style. The environment knowledge influences the quality of life of an individual, the family, the nation and the world. Environment also affects the health, particularly more of children, and it reduces the life time.
