To total rehabilitation process must include three parts

- Education of the in directed, their family and the community
- Medical based therapies
- Economic assistance as a motivator against social stigma

CAUSING FACTORS

CBR field workers found that many children with special needs in each village did not set appropriate education opportunities. They must be causes following factors.

- Parents of the children with special needs did not know where to bring them to set an appropriate education.
- Special schools were usually located in the central town and its cost more expensive than the regular schools.
- Some villagers thought the children with special needs had very limited abilities in accepting some lessons from the schools. it was useless to provide them a

formal education.

The regular elementary schools could not accept children with special needs, since they had no experiences and facilities to provide some assistance for children with special needs

PARENTS CONTRIBUTION TO CBR DEVELOPMENT

Parents potential contribution to CBR development is enormous, but in this chapter five possible areas will be explored ,where their efforts could make a significant difference.

ROLE PLAY IN EDUCATION

We all know that CBR has a major role to play in the education of the community, about disability, ignorance is a big obstacle, many people with disabilities are in their present situation because they did not know what to do at the time when, the "enemy" attacks them. Community members need to know has to prevent disabilities. They need to know how to care for, respect and communicable opportunity, with people with disabilities parents can make a major contribution towards sensitizing families in these areas by sharing their own experiences .they can encourage other parents to include their children in everyday activities ,by providing a sympathetic , listening ear to the familie's disabilities. They can also facilitate .referrals to medical and social services .their contribution in these areas can strengthen these aspects at a CBR programme considerably.

It should be offered to them and their usual way of living whether in a way that suits their usual way of living whether in a village, a town or a city.
