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ABSTRACT Learning begins right from the mother's womb till we attain the graveyard. Parent involvement is most successful when it is viewed, practiced, and promoted as a partnership between the home and school. The investigator was very inquisitive to know whether parental involvement creates positive or negative impact on their child's academic achievement. This study aims to find out the level of parental involvement and its relationship with academic achievement of children. By adopting survey method, information from 92 parents as randomly selected samples was collected through questionnaire to achieve the above mentioned aim. The finding of this investigation shows that, majority of the parents involved themselves in their child's education only at moderate level. And also proved that there is a commendable relationship exists between parental involvement and academic achievement of their children.

INTRODUCTION

Parental involvement is to deal with parenting skills in parent-child interactions, providing housing, health, nutrition, safety, home conditions to support study and providing information to schools to know their child. Parental involvement is most successful when it is viewed, practiced, and promoted as a partnership between the home and school. Parents are in fact the first teacher to their own children and it has become the enormous responsibility for them to bring up in right direction from home. . The utterance of numbers, letter sounds and later into meaningful lexical and semantic grows right from home with their parents. Theses sequential learning of a child would have taken through positive parents-child interactions and other scaffoldings. TOOL USED

To measure the parental involvement towards their child's education, the investigator prepared a questionnaire and standardized the same for investigation. The tool has 35 items and the responses were collected in 'Yes or No' format.
