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
### ABSTRACT



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


Here the population of boy's students in decreasing in each class and the number of girls still as it is.




The girls and boys are near about in same proportion in all standards. The population of girls is more than boys in every standard. There is no pattern of semi English in Hindi medium.

NANDED CITY VARIOUS COLLEGE LOCATION MAP





