ABSTRACT

Nakshatra is a term for lunar grange in Hindu Astrology, which is contemplated as 27 sectors along the ecliptic. They are the central axis around which Indian Astrology revolves. Their names are related to the most protuberant Asterism in the particular sectors. The planetary influence is significantly altered under the impact of Nakshatras as All Seeing Eyes or leading-light. From the very inception of Astrology, the *Ashlesha nakshtra* is considered as *rakshasa nakshtra* characterized by pestilential mentality, deceptiveness, strong sexuality, sharpness, and spontaneity. The distinguished pada *dosha* endorsed to this star in line with child birth and other malefic results experienced by a large group linked with premarital and post marital ill effects. The general tendency of human belief is that when somebody take birth in Ashlesha, he or she has cruel instincts, good leadership, judging ability, but insecurity also. These traits indicate a past life where the native was probably cheated or exploited. Thus, in this birth he or she will have that insecurity and sense of justice with a cruelty to punish.

Nakshtra is amalgamation of two parts of Hindi word "Naksha" (map) and "Tara" (star), meaning the map of stars. Ashlesha star's natural inclination is to look under the surface has to be utilized for understanding the hidden elements of nature functioning. Ashlesha does not seem to fit into the societal civilized structure because it is hard, sharp and dreadful Nakshtra. It has a lot to do with genetic heritage, the karma we have brought from previous life and the scope of changes allowed to make in present life in less. This star is considered to be an active Nakshtra which on surface appears to be a positive Nakshtra but in reality all its activities are hidden. Gender quality of Ashlesha Nakshtras is female because it includes feminine qualities like intuition, perception and deception. Meanwhile, the native is always weaving many webs on the mental plane but all its activities are hidden. Ashlesha is a downward Nakshtra which stands for and is fascinated in all things underground.

The symbol for this star is a coiled serpent and is ruled by the Nagas, serpent deities of wisdom. The snake signifies the Kundalini energy, which is the true essence of Aslesha. Poison and deception, as well as the power of intuition, insight and sexuality are all characteristics exemplified by Aslesha. This star represents primordial nature and is connected to past lives and genetic heritage. Aslesha is a challenging energy to grasp as it mysterious and suspicious, yet people born under this star are often astute observers. They sense danger quickly and are protective toward family and friends. Those born under Aslesha have an affinity for food and will not tolerate hunger, of any kind. This is a star of transformation and healing energy with an esoteric nature.

The four padas of Ashlesh star

Each Nakshatra is divided into four quarters called padas that contain more specific characteristics of a person born during the pada of Aslesha:

Ashlesha Star pada 1- $16^{\circ}\,40'$ to $20^{\circ}\,00'$ Cancer. Ruled by: Jupiter. Soul Sound: Dee

Keyword: Industrious Falls in the Dhanur navamsa, has the ability to put in hard work, has a lot to deal with enmity, diseases and 6th bhava affairs. People with Ashlesha nakshtra pada are very different from the above description yet the same. They are very caring and emotional people who build their huge wealth by giving more wealth to others and opening up charities around the world, however they are same as above description because they also use people in the process of building their wealth, however by giving money to charity balances out their karma. They often make quite good business men medicinal and pharmaceutical companies.

People usually suffer some illness related to Mercury, like nervous system, lungs and speech, and since Moon and Mind both represents our mind and intelligence, this may also affect them by being prone to depression. However, this nakshatra is also very good in detecting their own illness or illnesses of others, which makes them very good doctors and nurses.

People born under the nakshatra of Ashlesha pada 4 are very lucky in life. They get lot of wealth and happiness by their mothers and father and parents usually become a source of wealth. Strengths: Independent, clever, versatile, sharp, philosophical, entertaining, multiple occupations, seductive, gains through spirituality, passionate and disciplined when interested in topic; ability to accomplish greatness when motivated.

Weakness: Mental instability, nervous, depressed, moody, deceptive, tactless, lacking social skills, impolite, careless, selfish, secretive, detached, ungrateful, unpopular, introspective, reclusive, blunt, unappreciative, possessive, breaks the rules, scattered, unproductive.

The sacred energy vortex associated with Aslesha star is the shrine of Thirundhudevankudi Sri Karkadeswarar located in Thirundhudevankudi near Kumbakonam in Tamil Nadu, India. This temple is often referred to as NandanKoil by the local people. Those born under Aslesha star should worship at the temple at least once in their lifetime. The Goddess AdhiParasakthi bestows the grace of ArumarundhuNayaki at this temple. Aslesha is in the Zodiac sign of Cancer, which has many medicinal qualities and can offer assistance with taking medicines. If the Moon travels through Aslesha during the waning cycle, it is a powerful time for people to gain relief from illnesses and ailments. Aslesha is also a favorable star for conducting planetary (Navagraha) fire rituals or Dhanvantripoojas.

Male Natives born under Aslesha Nakshatra

Cat's instinctive hostility to rats symbolizing the mentioned Nakshatras account for Ashlesa's mutual non compatibility to Magha and Poorvaphalguni birth stars. Cat's instinctive affinity with hare, mongoose and monkey accounts for AshleshaNakshatra's compatibility with stars such as Anuradha, Sravana, Jyeshta, Poorvaashada and Uttarashada.

Ashlesha natives, your incense is made with the herb Beauty Leaf Poon as prescribed by the Vedas.

Burning one of these pillars is like performing a mini fire ritual for that particular star formation. For your specific Birthstar, you will be able to connect inwardly to your planet of energetic origin and gain support with the positive aspects that are you. Burning the other Nakshatra pillars on that specific Nakshatra day will tune you in with the favorable activities with that star's energy for the day. It is recommended to at least burn your own personal Nakshatra pillar daily to stay connected to your essence. It is advantageous to burn the days Nakshatra pillar as well.
