## The complications of severe dengue include:[5]

- Death.
- Bleeding.
- Exceedingly minimal platelet count
- Injury to lungs, heart, or liver.
- Relentlessly low blood pressure showing to cardiovascular system collapse.

## Diagnosis of Dengue:[4]

1. Blood test for leukocyte
2. Platelet and haematocrit
3. Viral RNA genome or soluble antigens (i.e. NS1 antigen)
4. Serology.

## The Dengue can be prevented if we are following things:[7]

1. Use mosquito repellents while sleeping.
2. Wear full sleeves.
3. Do not allow water to settle in the surrounding areas.
