- Automatic approval for Technology agreements in the hotel industry, subject to the fulfillment of certain specified parameters.
- Concession rates on customs duty of 25% for goods that are required for initial setting up, or for substantial expansion of hotels.
- 50% of profits derived by hotels, travel agents and tour operators in foreign exchange are exempt from income tax. The remaining profits are also exempt if reinvested in a tourism related project.
