Immune Thrombocytopenic Purpura (ITP) is an auto immune pathology characterized by a low platelet Count, purpura and hemorrhagic episodes caused by anti-platelet auto-antibodies. It occur when the immune system mistakenly attacks platelets. Annual Incidences of ITP is approximately 42,000 in India. ITP is a blood disorder that affects both children and adult, it is more common in females than Males.

INTRODUCTION What is ITP?

Immune Thrombocytopenic Purpura (ITP) is a blood disorder characterized by a decrease in the number of platelets in the blood. Platelets are blood cells that help stop bleeding. Low platelet counts can cause easy bruising, bleeding gums and internal bleeding. ITP is caused by an immune reaction against one's platelets in which the immune system mistakenly attacks own platelets and destroys them. So it is called Immune Thrombocytopenic Purpura.

Thrombocytopenia Means low platelet count in the blood.

Purpura refers to the purple discoloration of the skin with a bruise.

Causes Of ITP-:

ITP mostly occurs as a result of antibody production against platelets. In few cases a type of white blood cells called T-Cells attack platelets directly, this immune system error may be a result of any kind of the followings:

Symptoms of ITP-:

- Purpura- Bruise- The purple color of the skin in which blood has leaked under it.
- · Nose Bleeding
- Bleeding Gums/Mouth
- Blood in Vomit, Cough, Urine, or Stool
- Heavy Menstrual Blood Flow
- Bleeding in the Head. This is Most dangers complication of ITP

- Dynamic method of potentization is used for preparation in Hemodynamic medicines is LM potency Scale. This scale has the power of giving deep penetrating, long and fast acting results without any type of disease or medicinal aggravations.
- These medicines should be taken orally and are given at an interval of minimum 10 days before they manifest there action.
