The purpose of this study is to determine whether, with the use of Ayurveda, we can effectively treat dandruff through a daily routine (Dincharya Upakarma), such as massaging Abhangya to lessen symptoms and aid in prevention. Although having nice hair texture is something that everyone is enthusiastic about, in our day and age, bad eating habits, stress at work, a competitive lifestyle, a lack of time, making significant decisions quickly, following fashion trends, and other forms of pollution all play a part in the rise in illnesses. Numerous people have hair issues connected to this unhealthy lifestyle. A head massage therapy with Neem oil (Shiroabhyanga) is scheduled for patients who suffer from dandruff. Twice a day will be therapy. There was an examination both before and after treatment. For 21 days, the sample was examined and rated every 7 days based on subjective parameters. After the 21-day course of therapy, there were notable improvements in the symptoms, including a notable reduction in dandruff symptoms. Shiroabhyanga, or head massage, is a reasonably priced method for maintaining good hair that is simple, safe, and effective.

INTRODUCTION

In India, Ayurveda is the oldest and most conventional medical system. Maintaining health integrity is the primary goal of Ayurveda, followed by curing illness. Swasthavrutta, a distinct branch of Ayurveda, addresses health sciences and a code of behavior for well-being. One of the principle is "Swasthasya swasth Rakshanam", which is based on the preventive measures to prevent a healthy person to become unhealthy or sick [10]

Approximately 50% of adults globally suffer from hair dandruff. Even though it is not a fatal illness, in the second and third decades of life, it could become an aesthetic issue. Since the scalp constantly produces new skin cells, the process of dead skin cell shedding is also normal. Dandruff causes a quicker rate of skin cell shedding. Generally speaking, a person with dandruff will have scales from their scalp that fall like snowflakes and land on their garments, shoulders, and eyebrows as they brush or comb their hair. [9]

The current day is plagued with a number of ailments as a result of bad eating habits, stress from the workplace, a competitive lifestyle, a lack of time, large accomplishments made quickly, fashion fads, and other forms of pollution. Nowadays, market preparations can take the place of homemade treatments for everyone. They are rushing to save time, don't have time for self-care, and can fall victim to careless habits. Today's society requires fast living, thus bahirparimarjan in the form of Taila was chosen since it is simple to implement and serves as sthanikchikitsa for a fast life [3,4,5]. Dushti of Kapha, along with Pitta and Rakta dhatu, are seen in this case study. With all of this in mind, the treatment plan aims to relieve Pitta dosha, Rakta dhatu, and Kapha dosha, or Kapaha-Pittashamak and Raktashodhak...

Family - Meliaceae

Part used - flowers, leaves, seeds, oil, bark, root, fruits

Pharmacodynamics -Rasa - Tikta, Kashaya Guna-Laghu virya - Sheeta vipaka - katu doshghnata - Kapha Pittaghna

Chemical constituent -Bark contains bitter alkaloid margosine, nimbidin (0.5%), Nimbin (C28H40O8, 0.03%), Nimbinin (C27H30O9), Nimbosterol with volatileoil & 6% tannin, seeds contains about 31% of yellow bitter fixed oil. It contains 2% of bitter substance, which has nimbin, nimbinin, nimbidin & nimbidol.

Action - Paushtika, Jvarapratibandhaka, Grahi, Tvaka doshahara,Krimighna&Rasayana

Clinico pharmacological studies –Nimbidin, Nimbin & neem oil were discovered to have anti-inflammatory qualities. Leaf extracts prepared with alcohol showed promise in treating acute eczema, ringworm, and scabies. Dried leaves extracted with 70% alcohol are useful in various fungal-infected skin illnesses after being dried and soaked in propylene glycol

(4:6). It also had a healing effect on weeping acute and chronic eczema

Mode Of Action of Nimb taila-

Local application of oil or Abhyanga is an external oleation therapy. Skin or scalp is a route of administration of drugs according to Ayurveda, and it is considered equally important.

According to Acharya Charaka, Abhyanga is very beneficial for skin as it is having Vatahara properties; and Tvacha as Sparshanendriya mention as a Sthana of Vata. It is mentioned in classical Ayurvedic texts that Abhyanga is Twak Dardhyakara, Mruja Varna Balaprada (effective for cleansing of skin and it increases complexion of skin oil is absorbed from the scalp & gives the results to local diseases.

Bhrajaka Pitta has situated in the skin. Vitiation of Bhrajaka Pitta [7,8] present in kandu & ruksha skin. When a tila taila or nimba Abhyanga is applied to the face, the active components of the taila substance are released into the base. Following that, it passes through the Romakupa and is then absorbed by the Swedavahi Strotas and Shiramukha. There after it helps to pacifies and liquefy Pitta Dosha in blood and skin, and also supported to moisturizing function, so that extra heat of Pitta couldn't dry out the Rakta Dhatu more.

Nimba has Paushtika, Jvarapratibandhaka, Grahi, Tvaka doshahara,Krimighna & Rasayana properties. So used in the Arunshika, & gives good results. Also in many clinical studies it proves as a krimighna properties.

So in skin diseases like Arunshika $\,$ application in the form of tail gives a significant results.

CONCLUSION-

As described in Samhita Bhavprakash nighantu Nimba Have antimicrobial activity & good for skin. Removes all the dosha from the body. After clinical observation of 21 days with Nimba Oil application to scalp patient got relief Symptomatically relief upto 90 percent. So this case study proves that Nimba tail is effective for hair Dandruff (arunshika). No any adverse effects found during and after the treatment.

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
